

Environmental Policy

Demolition Plus is committed to ensuring that any demolition works carried out by, or on behalf of the company, has the minimum effect on the surrounding environment. All company employees and sub contractors, regardless of their position within the company, will be made aware of the requirements for environmental protection during any projects, regardless of their size or duration.

In order to achieve the high level of environmental protection required by Demolition Plus all parties shall adopt the following principles:

- Demolition Plus actively encourages all employees and subcontractors to report situations with which concerns are raised as to the protection of the environment.
- The requirements of the relevant authorities must be ascertained in relation to the control of noise, dust and water pollution.
- All work is carried out in a manner that will cause the least disturbance to the environment.
- Demolition Plus requires that all employees and subcontractors work towards achieving procedures which ensure environmental protection.
- A site specific drainage and erosion control plan will be devised with adequate control measures to prevent environmental contamination in order to meet the relevant authorities' requirements.
- Where appropriate, signs and barricades will be put in place to protect specific areas that possess environmental significance, or do not require demolition.
- It is the responsibility of every person on site to ensure that safe work practices are carried out in order to achieve environmental protection. Demolition Plus management will ensure that adequate support and supervision is given to the supervisor and all employees in order to achieve this.
- Constant monitoring of all environmental controls will be conducted with ongoing improvements phased into work procedures.
- Where hazardous materials such as asbestos and PCB's are required to be removed, this shall be carried out in accordance with the requirements of WorkCover Authority and shall be disposed off in accordance with EPA Requirements.
